## project goals

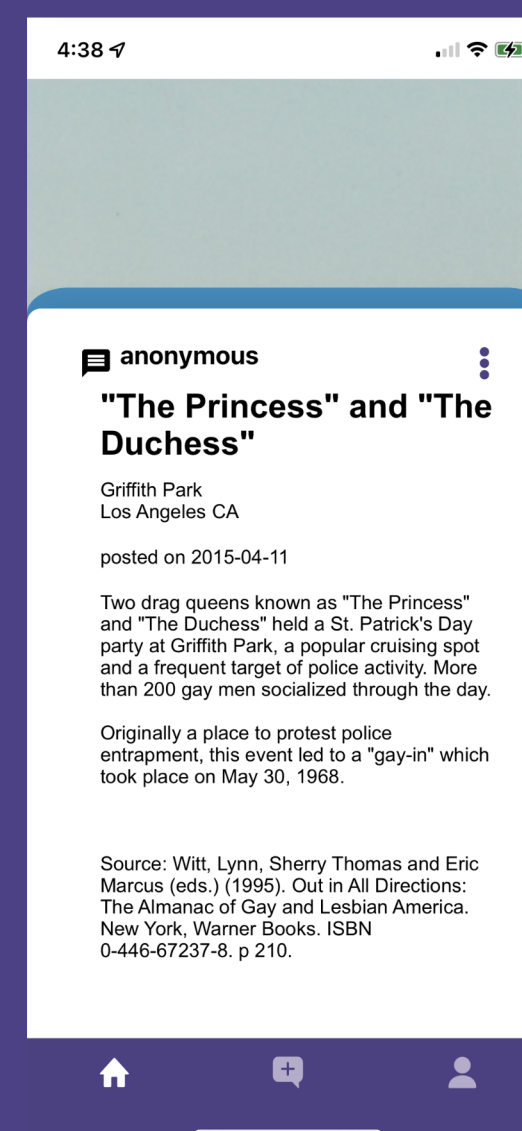
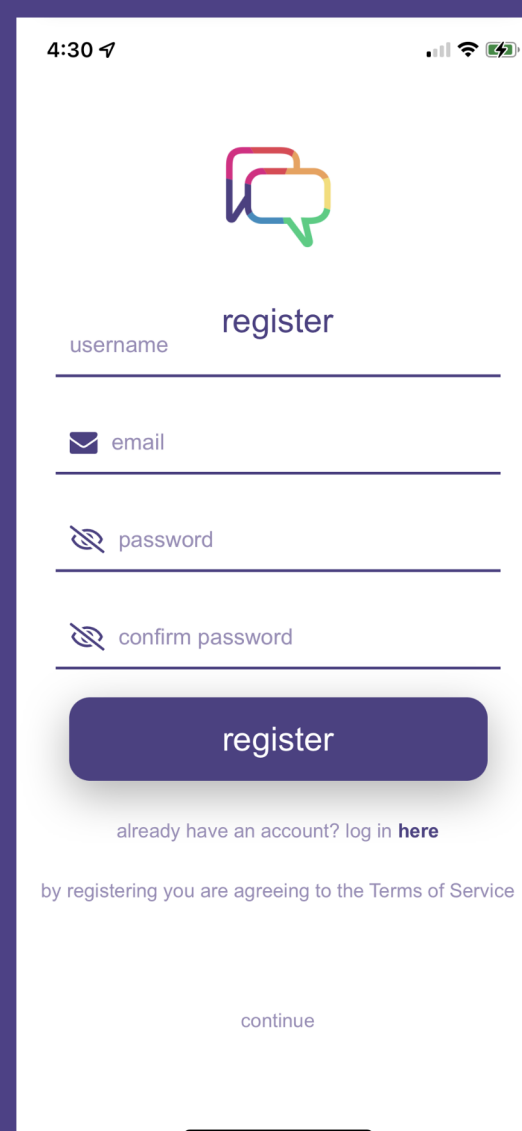
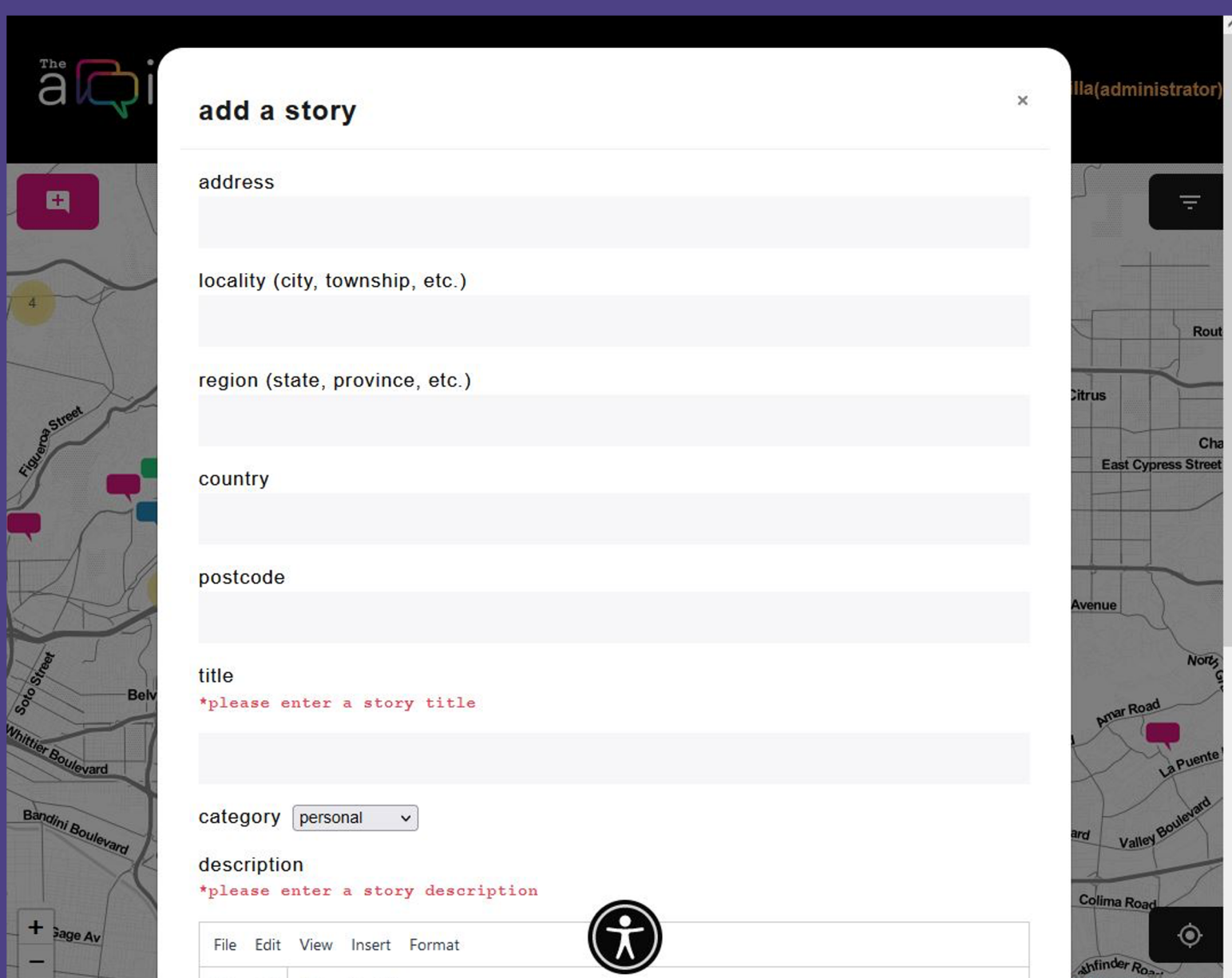
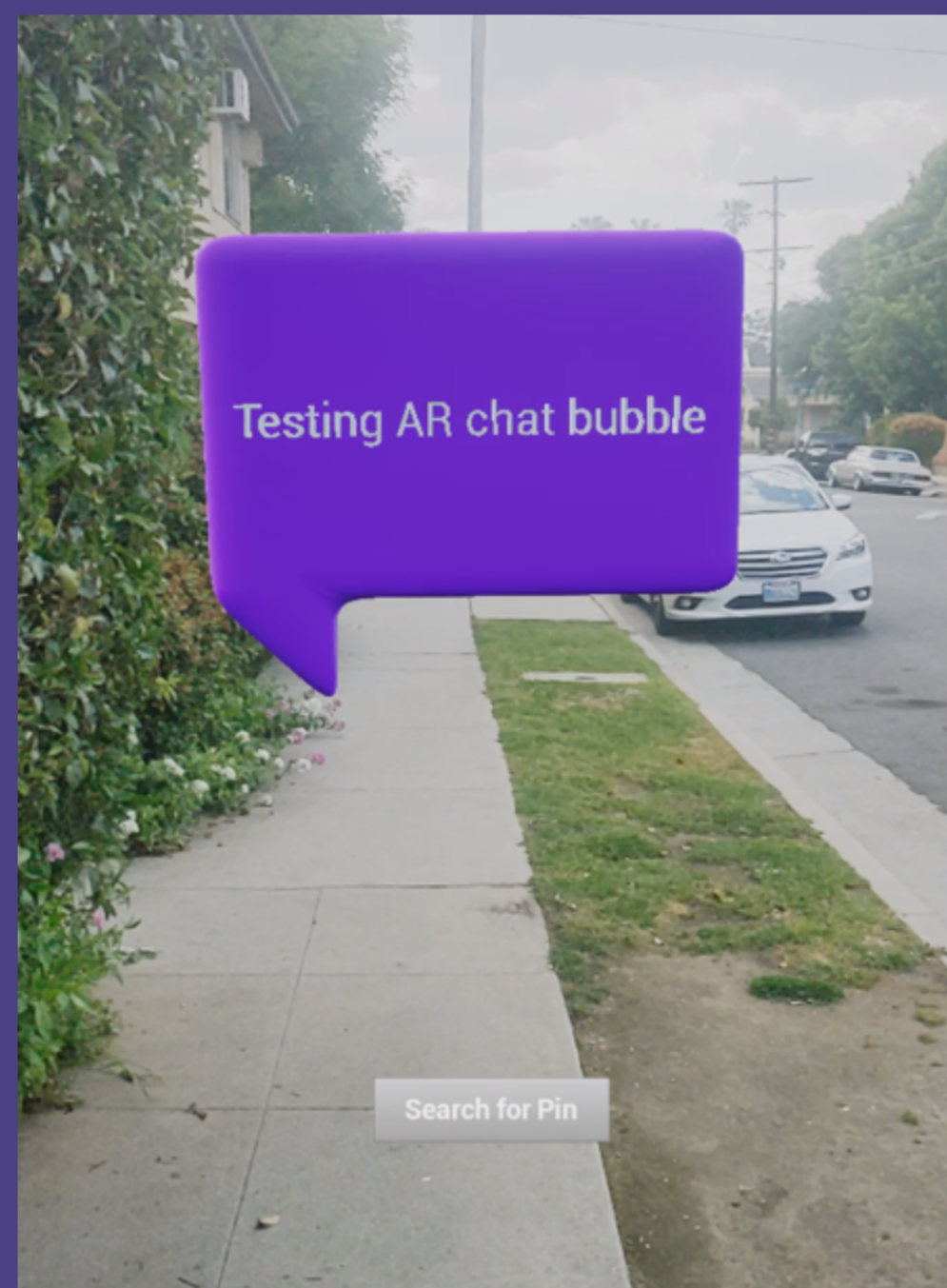
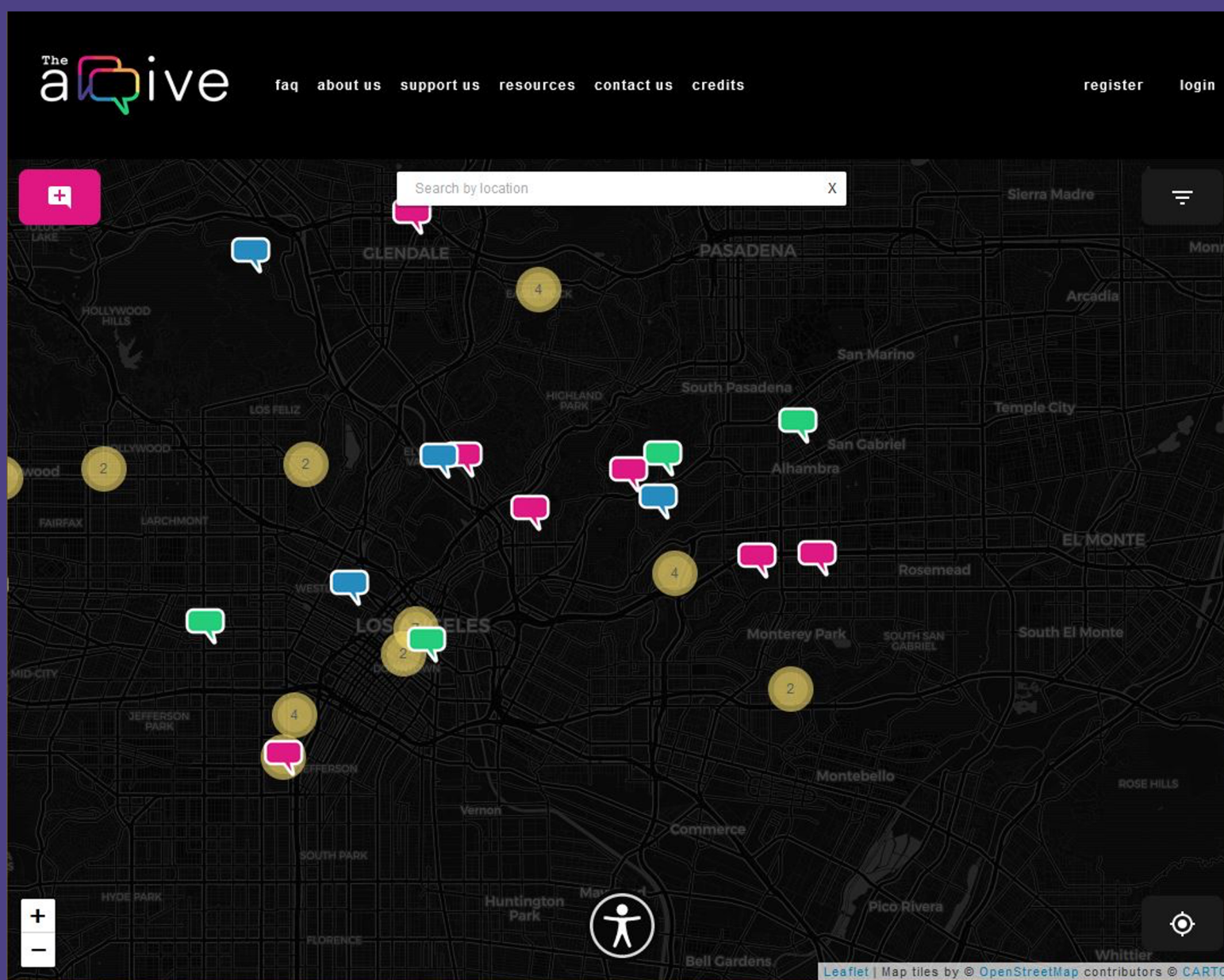
Our objective this year was to expand upon the progress made in the last two years, including:
