**WHEREAS:** The California State Legislature passed AB 928, mandating a common lower-division general education (GE) transfer pattern between the California Community Colleges system, the California State University system, and the University of California system; and

**WHEREAS:** The Intersegmental Committee of Academic Senates (ICAS), which includes faculty representation from the Academic Senate for the California Community Colleges, the Academic Senate of the California State University (ASCSU), and the University of California Academic Senate, developed a common transfer GE pattern based on faculty input across all three systems and based on the current GE patterns in all three systems; and

**WHEREAS:** This California General Education Transfer Curriculum (Cal-GETC) must be approved by the three systems’ Senates before the end of December 2022; and

**WHEREAS:** The Academic Senate of Cal State LA has reviewed the new Cal-GETC pattern and discussed the consequences of its approval and of not approving the pattern; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the Academic Senate of Cal State LA supports the new Cal-GETC pattern; and be it further

**RESOLVED:** That the Academic Senate of Cal State LA instructs our ASCSU representatives to vote in favor of the ICAS Cal-GETC proposal at the ASCSU November 2022 plenary; and be it further

**RESOLVED:** That this resolution be distributed to the Academic Senate of the CSU (ASCSU) Executive Committee before the close of business Tuesday, October 25, 2022 in preparation for the November ASCSU plenary.
