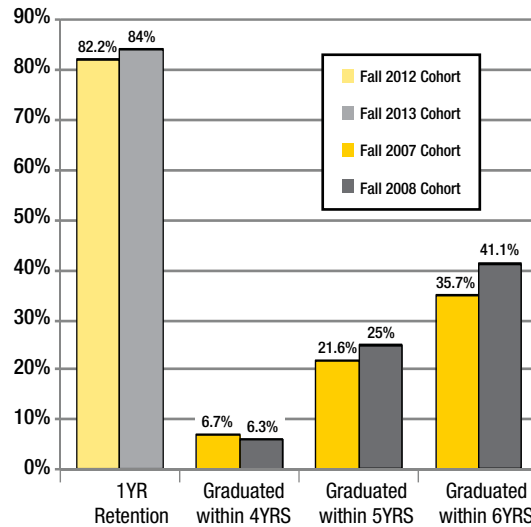

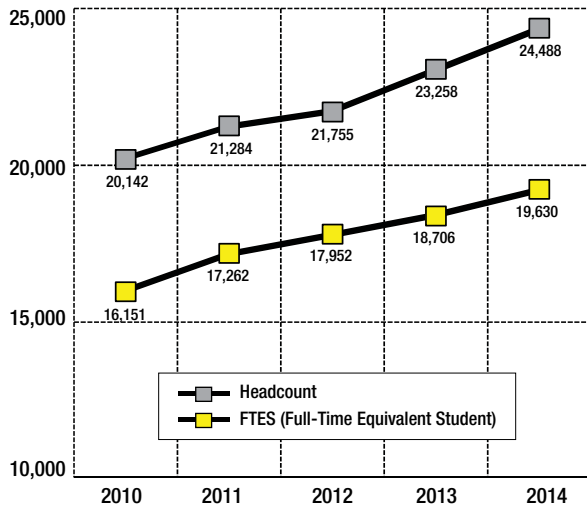
Retention and Graduation Rates*

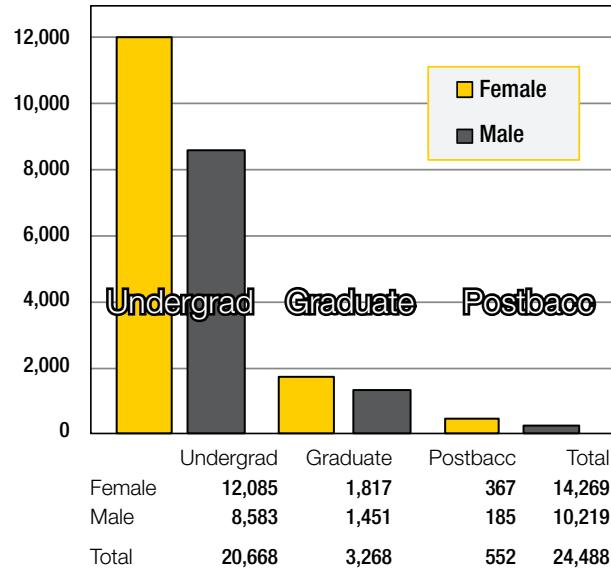
• The average study load is 12.8 units for undergraduates, 9.2 for graduates/postbaccalaureates, and 12.2 overall.

Average Age

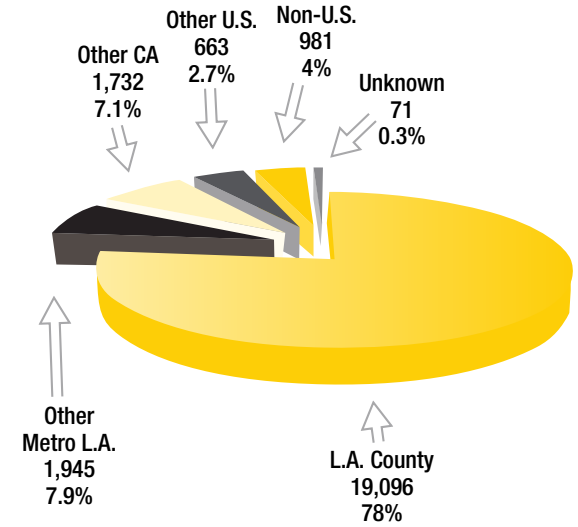
The average age* of undergraduates is 23.2, while that of graduates and postbaccalaureates is 30.9. The average for the combined group is 24.4.

Headcount by Gender

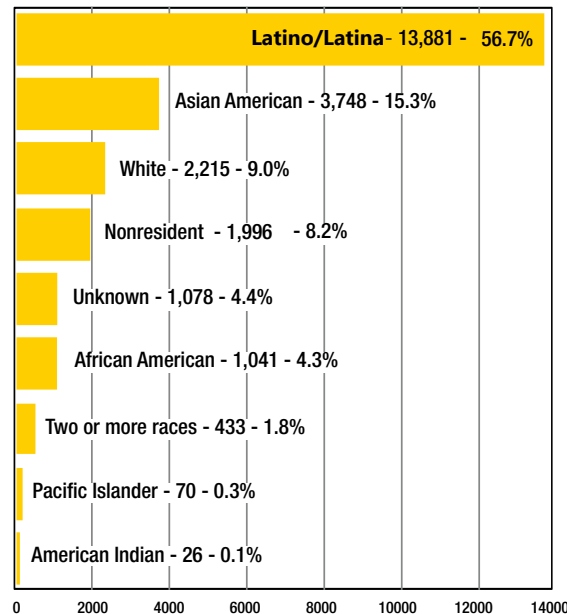


Headcount by Geographic Area
