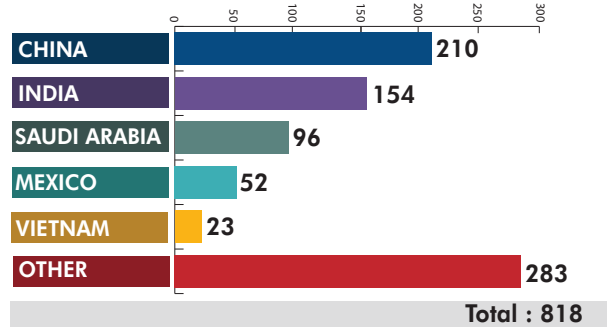

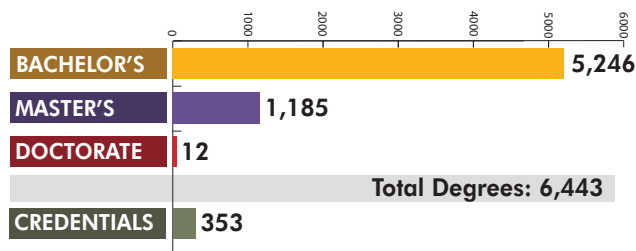

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS BY COUNTRY OF CITIZENSHIP*

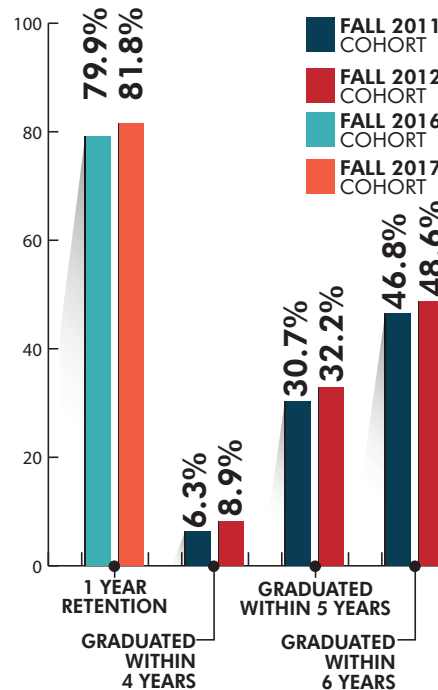

2017-2018 DEGREES AWARDED



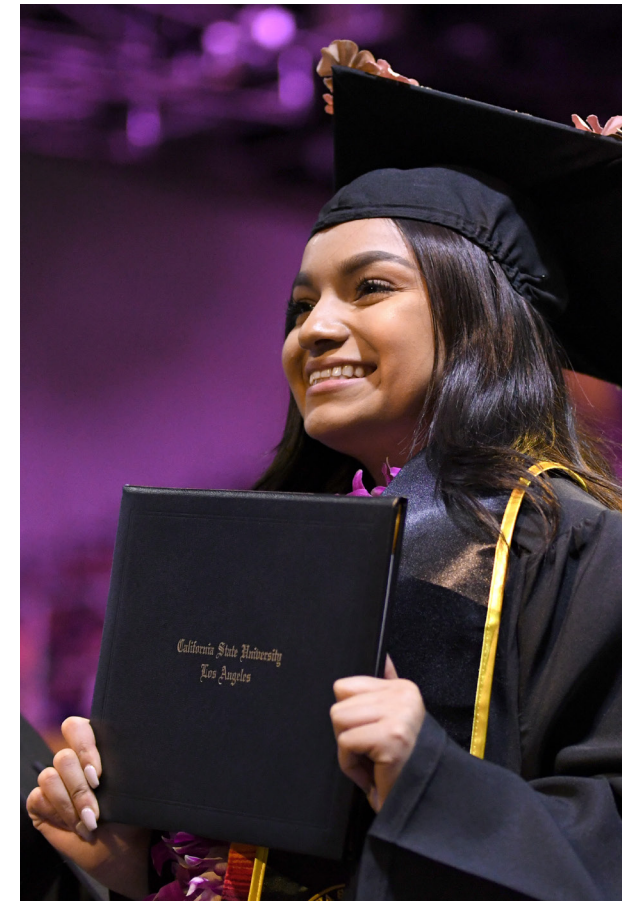
RETENTION AND GRADUATION RATES*

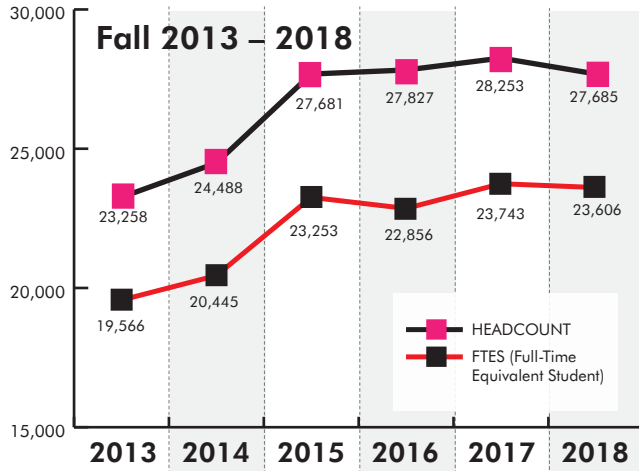

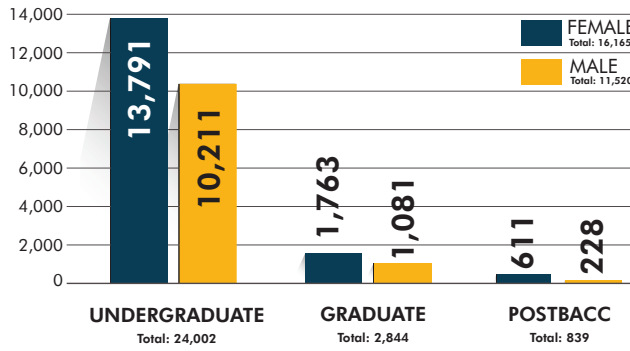

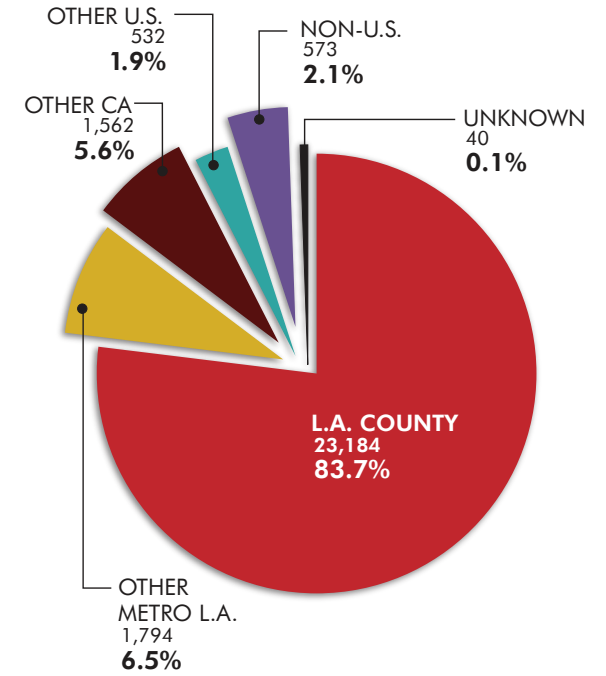
HEADCOUNT + FTES (Full-Time Equivalent Student)



HEADCOUNT BY GENDER

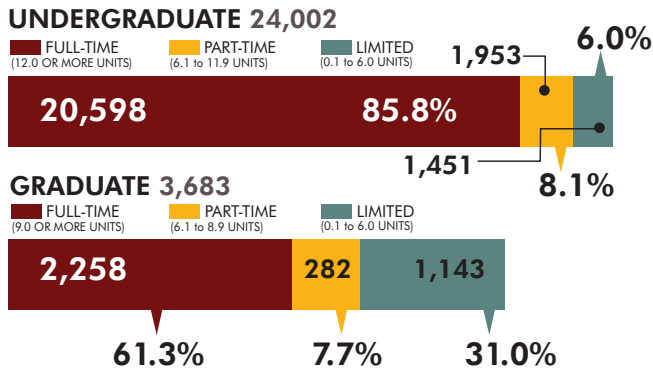


HEADCOUNT BY GEOGRAPHIC AREA

The average study load is 13.1 units for undergraduates, 9.3 for graduates/postbaccalaureates, and 12.6 overall.

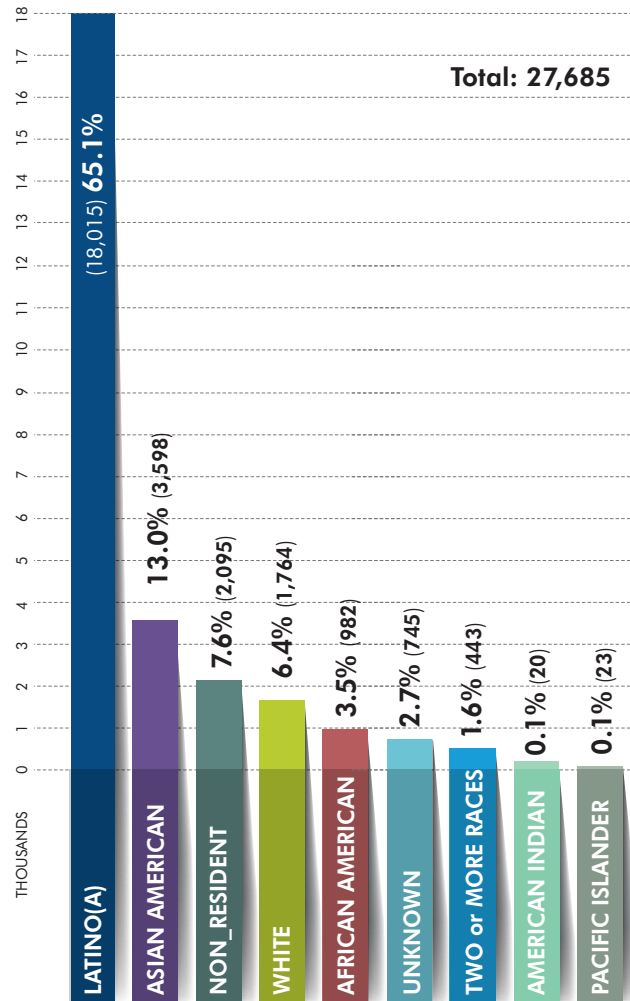
AVERAGE AGE
