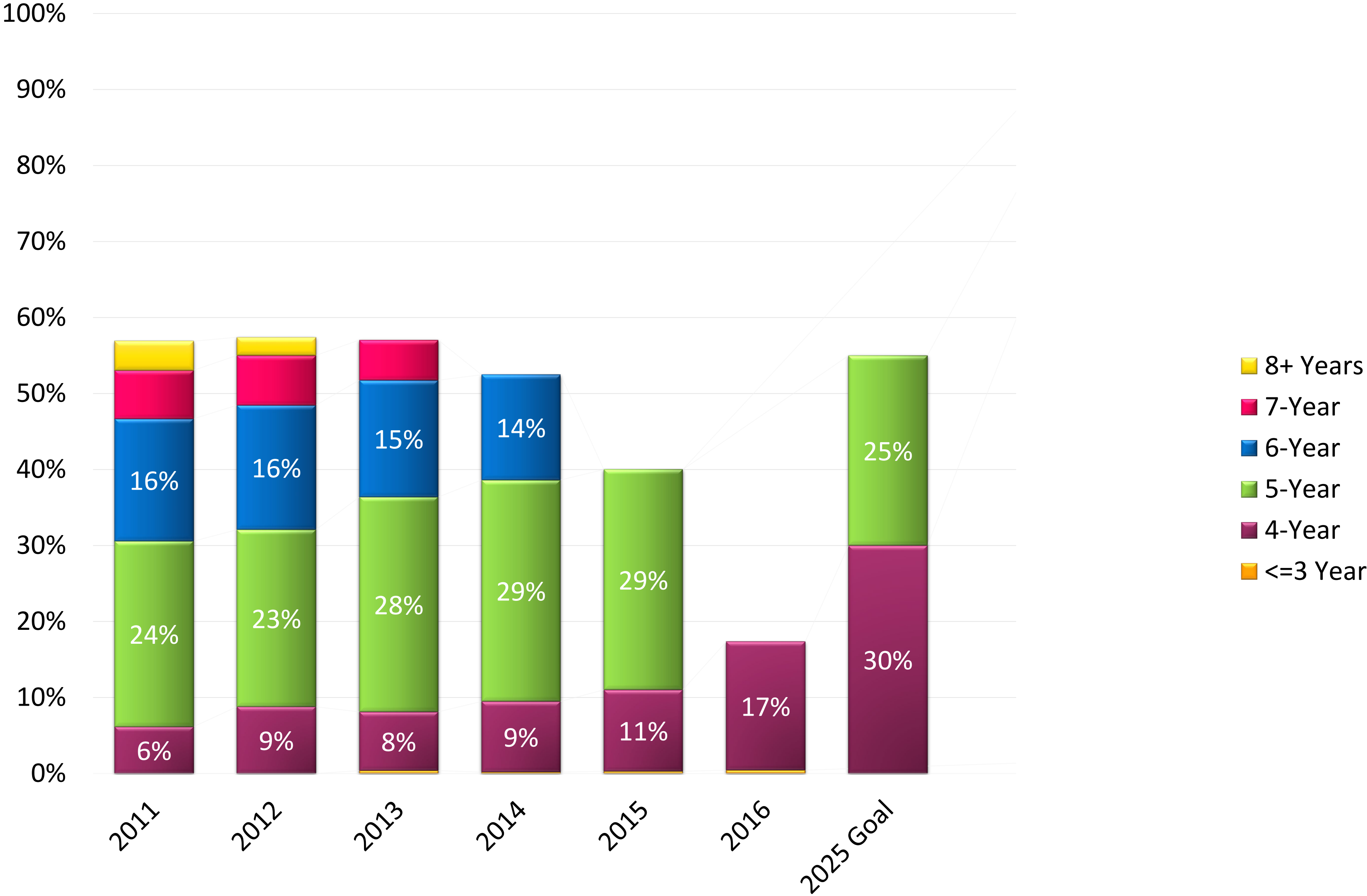

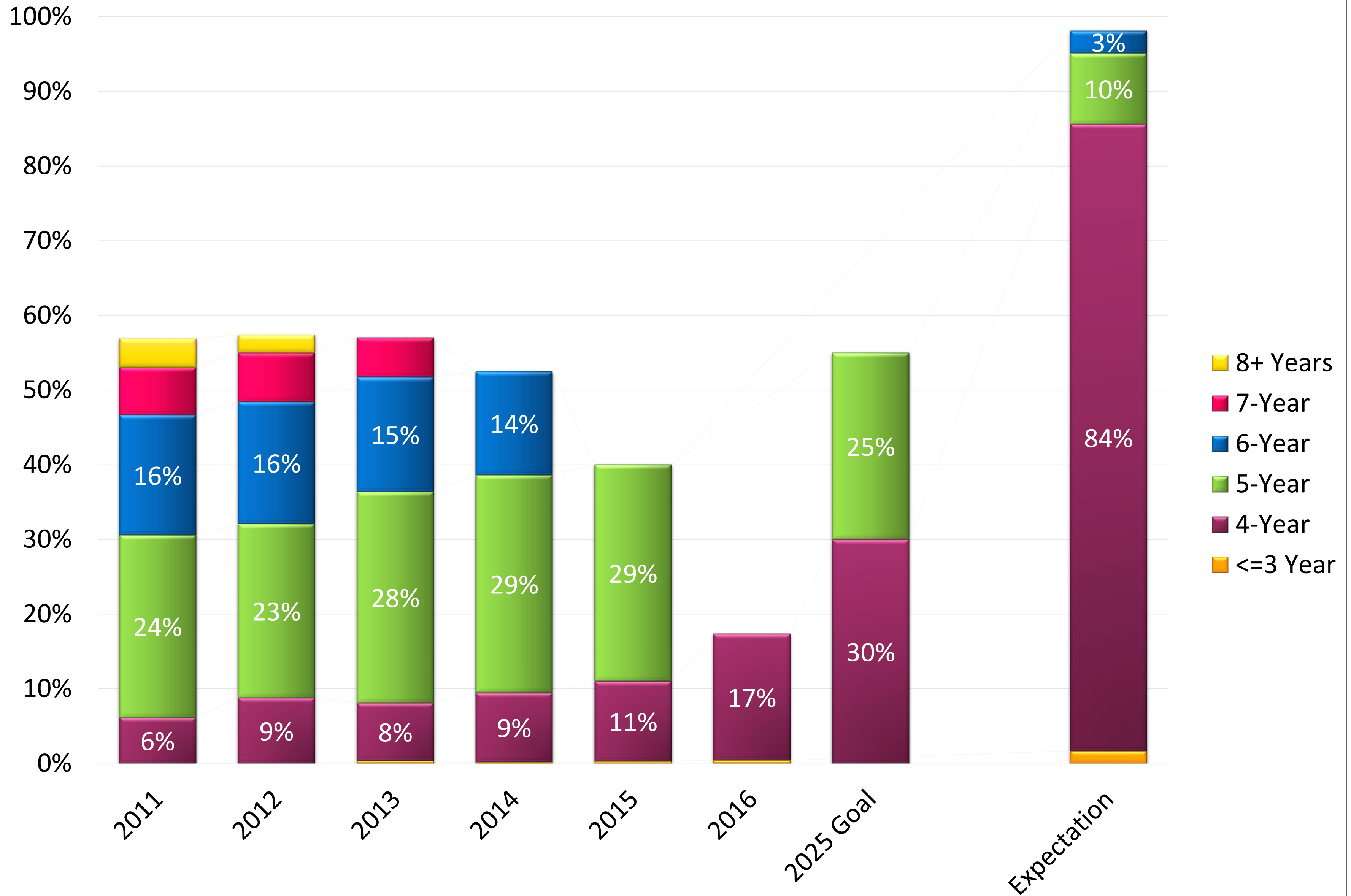

# First Time Freshman Years to Graduation by Cohort Year



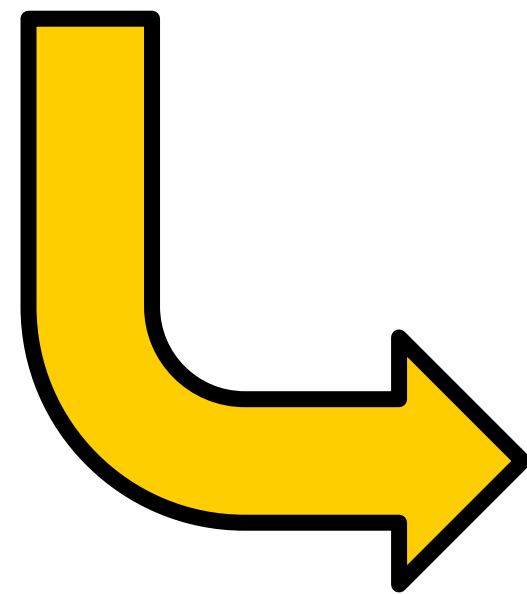
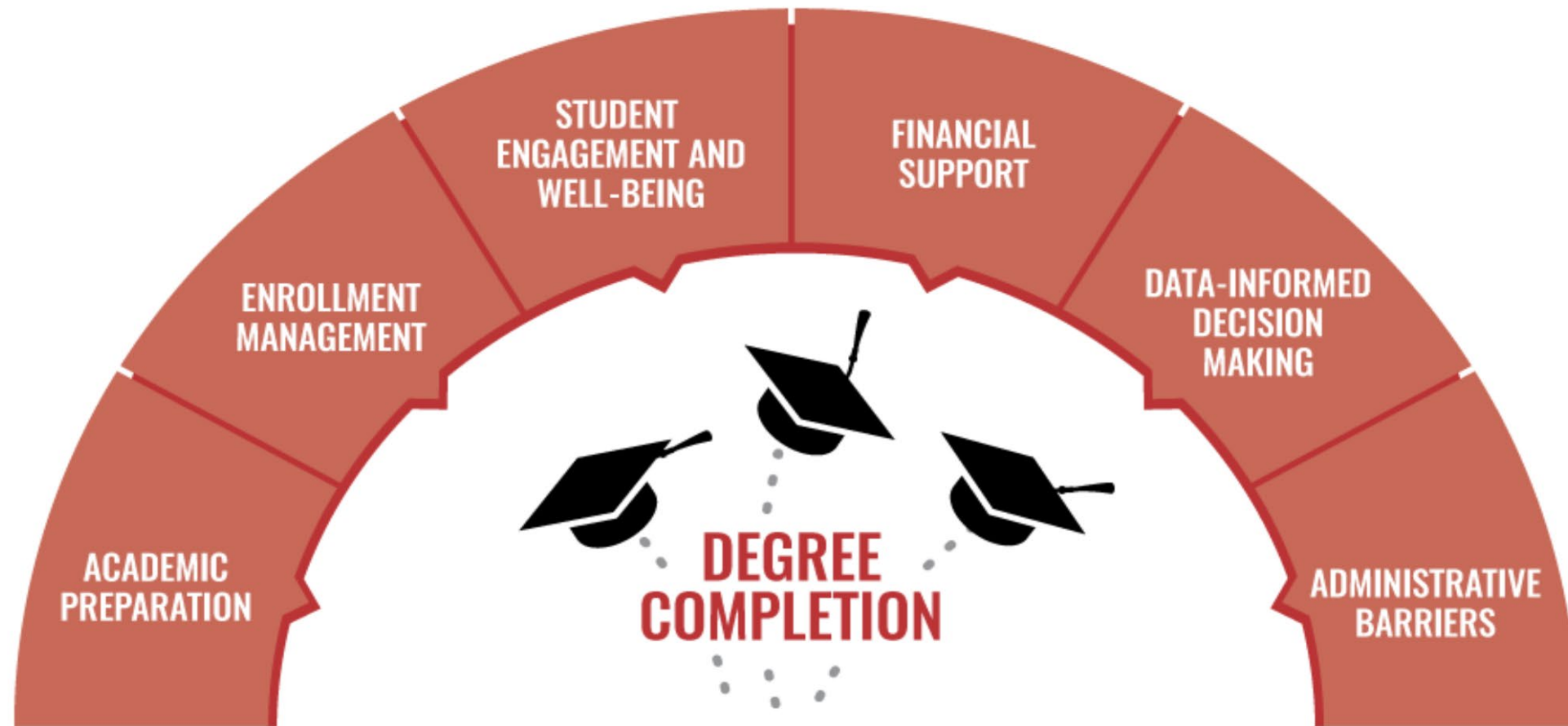
# First Time Freshman Years to Graduation by Cohort Year

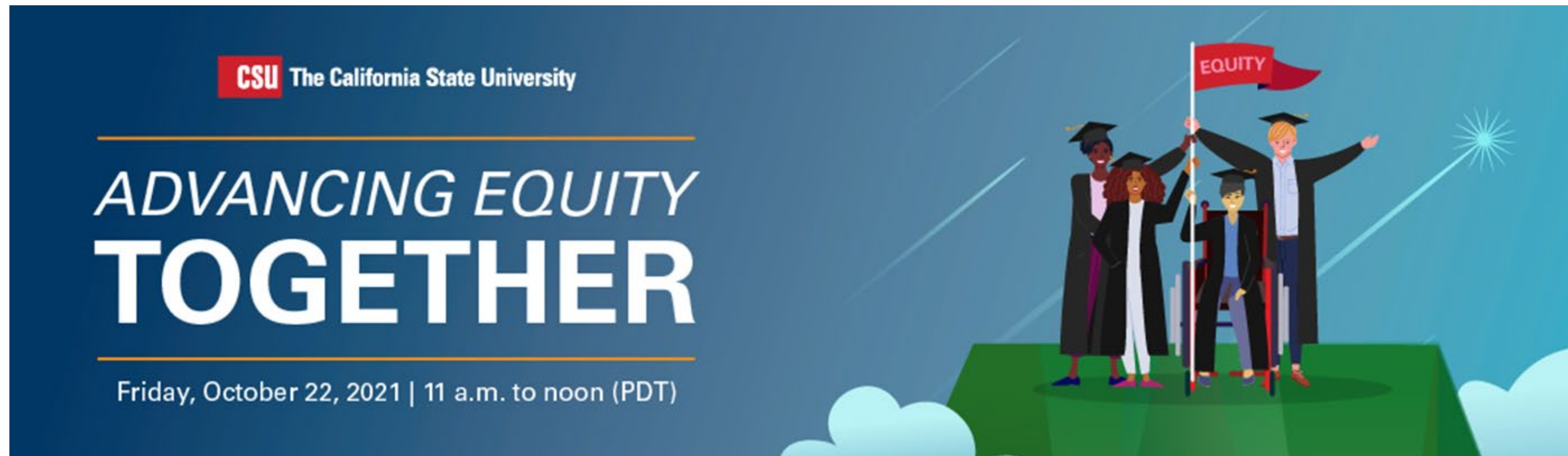
