Preliminary Admission to the Credential Program

- Admission to the CSULA
- A 2.75 grade point average in the last 90 units attempted
- Completion of an application to the Charter College of Education plus the \$65.00 fee
- Official and sealed transcripts
- Philosophy and Education Statement
- Two (2) Letters of recommendation
- Verification of negative TB test taken within last twelve (12) months
- Certificate of Clearance issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC), valid CCTC credential, or Emergency Permit
- Technology Proficiency
- Verification of CBEST attempted (all section)

Formal Admission to the Credential Program

- Credit grade for EDCI 300
- Passing grade for EDFN 413 ("C" grade or better)
- Passing grade for PH 457 ("C" grade or better) 9/5/2011 changed from HS 457
- Passing grade for MATH 110 ("C" grade or better)
- Speech proficiency-COMM 150 or 151 ("C" or "CR" grade or better)
- Writing Proficiency Examination (UNIV 400)(applied to all students) or score of 41 or higher on the writing portion of the CBEST (applied to graduate students only)
- Verification of multiple subjects CSET passed (all three subtests) for graduate students (undergraduates exempted as admissions requirement, but must meet prior to directed teaching))

Requirements for the Preliminary Credential

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- U.S. Constitution requirement (POLS 150, equivalent course or examination)
- Passing score for CBEST (all sections)
- Passing score for CSET (all sections)
- All required credential program coursework plus directed teaching or demonstration of instructional of instructional competencies and completion of teaching portfolio
- Passage of Teacher Performance Assessment (TPA)-when available
- Passage of RICA
- Completion of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training

Subject Matter Competency

Subject matter competency must be achieved through examination (MSAT or CSET).
